Dear Parents / Guardians,

The students of Division 1 and 2 will be participating in ski school at Seymour Mountain to supplement our Physical and Health Education curriculum.

This opportunity to participate in a Ski / Snowboard experience at Mount Seymour for four sessions:

- 1.) Monday, January 27th
- 2.) Monday, February 3rd
- 3.) Monday, February 24th
- 4.) Monday, March 30th

All participants will enjoy lessons at their level. New skiers / snowboarders will have the chance to develop skills that increase their ability and interest. They will be introduced to the joy of winter sports.

In addition to skills, etiquette and responsibility, they will learn the safety principles they need for their future winter sport experiences. Beginners will learn the basics. Intermediate participants will have the chance to hone their skills. Seasoned individuals will be challenged to further develop their expertise.

Mount Seymour personnel will provide lessons, supervision, and lunch for all of our students. Skiers and snowboarders will be evaluated on the first day to determine their proficiency and then placed in a group accordingly. Each student will receive a 4-hour lesson each day that matches their level of comfort / ability.

Skiing and snowboarding time can also be enjoyed after the lesson, under the guidance of a Seymour ski instructor/supervisor, so that our students can further practice what has been learned.

Transportation from the school and back will be by parent volunteers. The road to Mount Seymour is designated as a winter tire or chain up route. Use of winter tires or M+S tires in good condition must be used or vehicles must carry chains between October 1st and March 31st. We will leave the school promptly by 8am and arrive back at school by ~4:30pm. Parents will need to make arrangements to pick up their children from school at this time. We can only participate if we have enough parent volunteers to drive students to and from Seymour mountain.

The cost will be \$285. This includes lift tickets, equipment rental, 4-hour group lessons, supervision / guidance during free time, and hot lunch. The cost is \$250 if you have your own equipment.

Students at Laurier Elementary strive to S.O.A.R. at school and when in the community! We all work hard to be excellent ambassadors of our school.

Students must dress appropriately and bring clothes to change into. Should the ski program be jeopardized by weather, all programs will be postponed and rescheduled.
