<ul> <li>Include any past         assessments/evaluations         that shows how you         improved</li> </ul>	- Monitor comments to make sure they are appropriate and relevant
- Explain how you improved	<ul> <li>Add any additional things noticed about the learning of the student</li> </ul>
- Explain what you learned based on the learning intentions, success criteria, questions, self/peer assessments, feedback, etc.	- Focuses students on the learning process (Big 6 Principles)
<ul> <li>Include what you would do next time to do even better</li> </ul>	

## **Example learning reflection:**

I got 3/16 on the pre-test and 16/16 on the final test. I improved a lot after practicing and learning what the words meant. It is clear to me that if I work hard, I will continue to improve. I think I met the learning intentions because I understand the meaning of all the words. What I would do next time is use each of the words in a sentence so I know how to use them properly.
